B. Tax Return

In the years 2019, 2020, 2021 tax returned were filed on time before April 15 each year. (Many thanks to Mr. Charles Cha who helped file MBCA's tax returns free of charge)

C. CA Government Registration

Each year, non-profit organizations must file annual registration by May 15 with tax return forms and registration forms. 2019, 2020 were in paper forms. 2021 was in Eform. Each year's registration was done timely.

D. Finance.

- 1. The land Drs. Peter and Grace Wang donated in Oct. 2019 was sold right before the pandemic in early 2020. The sale amounts to \$453,991.67. This amount was set aside by the board of directors as future fund to purchase a property so as to establish a Drs. Peter and Grace Wang Chinese Culture Center which will also serve as the administration site for the Monterey Bay Chinese Association.
- 2. The house Drs. Peter and Grace Wang donated has been renting out. The rent collected is used for the daily operation cost of events/activities of MBCA. Right now MBCA account has a balance around \$25,000.00(not exact). The MBCA finance is managed by a team headed by a vice president.
- 3. Many thanks to Jane and Victor Shaw's annual donation, and to Bamboo Yu and Sun Yongling's donations.
- E. **MBCA By-Laws Revision**: In 2019, the Board of Directors selected the By-Law Revision Committee which was headed by Dr. Danni Lu as Chair, and Charles Fuller, Zhenlin Qiao, Qian Xian as members. The committee completed the draft in late 2019. But due to the Pandemic, the Board of Directors only began to work on the By-Laws in March 2022 and after rounds of meetings, the board finalized and passed the revised By-Laws on August 6th, 2022. The revised By-Laws is expected to be submitted to CA Government before May 15th, 2023 at the time when MBCA registration is done or at a time set by the CA government as there appears to be an extension about it.

F. Membership

Even though there was the Pandemic from 2020-2023, the Monterey Bay Chinese Association has been growing fast from 2019 to 2023. Up till now MBCA has just over 100 lifetime members and a dozen annual members. This evidently indicates that the association is very welcomed by the Chinese community and the larger community. MBCA is a doing a great job in making impacts in Monterey Peninsula. MBCA membership is managed by a specific board member.

G. Chinese School

The Chinese School operated in 2019 full year, the school director was Minghua Wong laoshi. The school paused its operation in 2020, 2021, 2022, and resumed its operation in Jan. 2023. Current school's director is Huang Shanshan laoshi. Current school location: First Baptist Church of Monterey, 600 Hawthorne Street, Monterey.
