Origin of American Independence Day

Independence Day (also known as Fourth of July or July Fourth) is one of the main legal holidays in the United States. The war between Great Britain and its North American colonies began in April 1775. As the war continued, achieving freedom and independence from Great Britain became the goal pursued by the British colonies. On July 4, 1776, representatives of the thirteen colonies in North America held the Continental Congress in Philadelphia and passed the Declaration of Independence by Thomas Jefferson. The beginning of the Declaration of Independence clearly stated that all men are created equal and have the natural right to pursue happiness and liberty. It listed the crimes committed by Britain on the American continent, and declared the independence of the British North American colonies.

The Declaration of Independence is a great document with world-historical significance. The day when the Declaration of Independence was passed is also designated as the Independence Day of the United States, which has become the eternal symbol of the American people.

Tai Chi Practice

Tai Chi is an ancient Chinese martial art and a form of movement meditation. It has beneficial effects on physical and mental health.
